A polite reminder to our Sponsors

Secondary Fees are now due. December and January are very busy months in Kenya as students finish exams and prepare for the next school year. We need your donations as soon as possible to ensure we have funds on hand to wire to Kenya in time for the start of the new school year. As we noted last year, due to inflation in Kenya, our annual sponsorship fee for secondary students is now \$600.

After Graduation – what's next for donors?

Donor sponsors who are able to continue their support have two options when a secondary student graduates:

- Sponsor a new Form 1 student for a further 4 years, or
- Assist a high achieving secondary graduate in a post secondary program. Contact us for details on projected costs and your options.

Many options for donations. Our web site has several options for donating, and all donations will be tax receipted. Note that 100% of ALL donations in support of students goes directly to students in Kenya. Our operational costs - which are low because we are all volunteers - are raised separately through craft sales, specific donations or other special fund raising events.
